- **Invitation to participate in the artist-in-residence final performance 9th and 10th December!** The dance collective *Johanssons pelargoner och dans* end their period as artists-in-residence at Södertörn University and Huddinge municipality by presenting a new interactive artistic work on three different occasions the 9th and 10th December. - Two projects from **SH Innovation** entered the KTH Innovation Pre-Incubator Program! Södertörn University has had its first two innovation projects accepted into the KTH Innovation Pre-Incubator Program. Södertörn University's innovation office - SH Innovation - collaborates with KTH, Mälardalen University, and Stockholm School of Economics within the framework of KTH Innovation. SH Innovation also work in close collaboration with Drivhuset Stockholm. For the first time this year, two innovation projects that have emerged from SH Innovation have been accepted into the KTH Innovation Pre-Incubator Program. In this year's cohort 2 out of 20 innovation projects have their origin at SH Innovation.
