- The European Institute for Innovation and Technology (EIT) Strategic Innovation Agenda (SIA) for the upcoming program period (2021-2027) introduces the launch of new EIT Knowledge and Innovation Communities. The first new Community is set to focus on the **cultural and creative industries (CCI): EIT Culture & Creativity**. - EU institutions reached a deal last Friday on the union's next research and innovation programme and the breakdown of its budget. The final agreed budget for Horizon Europe is €95.5 billion, in current prices, which includes a €4 billion top-up due to a recent compromise deal with member states and €5 billion to come out of the EU's new COVID stimulus fund. All proposals applying for EU-funding require internal co-funding for the university's operational overhead, therefore need to be pre-approved by the vice-chancellor, so please contact the central research support administration (Brigitta or Gabriela) for more information and admin support!*
